At Coinford, we are acutely aware of the impact our industry can have on the environment. We are doing whatever we can to minimise this impact, and constantly review our processes to work in a smarter and more environmentally-friendly way. We remain committed to protecting the Environment and preventing damaging pollution. We will ensure we remain compliant with Environmental legislation and set Environmental objectives every year to drive continuous improvement.

While construction is in progress, we have people on-site whose responsibility it is to ensure that there is minimal environmental damage, disruption or nuisance on or adjoining the site. We understand the implications of noise, air, water and waste pollution, and adopt appropriate working practices.

We use recyclable materials in our formwork wherever possible and all our timber is from sustainable sources.

And in the interests of good public relations, we always inform and consult with local residents regarding works, and give them a contact on-site who can deal with queries.

In addition to this the company attempts to meet and, where appropriate, exceed the compliance requirements of all identified legislation. Where no regulations exist, Coinford will set its own standards whilst monitoring its impact on the environment.

Coinford will attempt to achieve this by:

- Where practicable, reduce the consumption of materials in all its operations through the re-use and non-disposal of wastes whilst promoting (where possible) re-cycling and the use of recycled products / materials.
- Consider all appropriate energy efficiency measures on existing or replacement equipment & fittings.
- Encourage employee involvement on environmental awareness through training programmes and Company practices for all personnel.
- Work with our supply sources to encourage their involvement in achieving our aims.
- Set & review objectives, targets and other types of improvement activities in order to improve our environmental performance.
- To monitor its progress and periodically make available its results to interested parties.
- Deliver a commitment to the continual improvement of its operations & the prevention of its operational pollution.

Coinford Management initiatives play a major role in environmental progress and change. The Operations and Production Directors are empowered to make decisions for the effective environmental management of its sites.
